# Cheshire West Warm Welcoming Spaces Fund Evaluation April 2023 – Summary Report



### **Key Findings**

<u>Cheshire Community Action</u> (CCA) has been working with CWaC and CWVA to administer, promote and distribute the Warm Welcoming Spaces Fund targeted to community organisations across the borough during Autumn/Winter 2022-23. Key findings from the evaluation:

- Total grant funding spent: £29,501.62
- Average grant amount claimed: £614.62
- Number of grants approved: **50**
- Weekly capacity of Warm Welcoming Spaces across the borough: 2,297
- Estimated total weekly attendance across Cheshire West in all Warm Welcoming Spaces: 1,8061
- Average weekly venue capacity of Warm Welcoming Spaces: 48
- Average weekly attendance numbers for each Warm Welcoming Space: 38
- Estimated total attendance across all Cheshire West in all Warm Welcoming Spaces during Autumn/Winter 2022-23: 15,226<sup>2</sup>
- Average cost per visit to Warm Welcoming Spaces across Cheshire West: £1.94<sup>3</sup>
- Number of groups that intend to continue providing a warm / community space: 29 (88% of respondents to the evaluation survey)




### **Locations of Venues**
